Proof of payment must be shown to the LOC upon arrival.

All delegations must stay in the official hotel of this event, to make it possible for the LOC to provide the necessary health protection measures due to Covid-19 pandemic.

#### **MEALS**

*Breakfast* is included in the accommodation expenses (also for extra persons).

Lunch will be provided by the organizers in the hotel on Friday, Saturday and Sunday (only for gymnasts, coaches and judges and only if hotel reservations are made through the LOC).

*Dinner* will be provided by the organizers in the competition hall on Friday and Saturday (only for gymnasts, coaches and judges and only if hotel reservations are made through the LOC)

- <u>Thursday</u>: Dinner-boxes can be ordered; Costs: € 8,50. Form must be returned by 15.10.2018

The LOC can provide lunch (€25,00) and dinner (€15,00) for extra persons. The costs of the meals are per person and per meal.

The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresees that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their delegation.  Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The OC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: 10 EUR per person/day.

## COVID-19

Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions. The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible. The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout. Directives 3 / 4 Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.

The specifics of the applied measures will be communicated one month before the event regarding to standard changes by health authorities in Belgium at the time of the event. Guidelines Belgian government: https://www.info-coronavirus.be/en/fag/

We ask all delegation members (older than 6 years old) to provide negative PCR-test on arrival.
