The Team performed well and achieved Bronze Team medal behind German Teams who came 1st and 2nd. In the Apparatus Finals, Loriah James won the Bronze medal on Floor, Silver medal on Vault and individually came joint 5th Overall.

Katy Bramley individually came 4th Overall.

Lucy Brett won a Bronze medal on Beam apparatus and finished individually joint 5th Overall.

Congratulations to these gymnasts.

Friday 11th :

Our first open training session in the competition arena was at 6:00pm on the Friday that we travelled from England. The girls had been up over 12 hours by this time so Leigh and I agreed the priority of the session was to adjust to the equipment and do only part routines. After warm up on floor area we started on bars, gymnasts liked the bars and performed all that was required from them in that session. We moved to beam where once again the girls adjusted to the difference in firmness of the beam, Leigh led the session on beam and I just added as and when needed. The girls worked hard and listened to all instructions.

Floor was next and all gymnasts were asked to perform all their tumbles from their routines which each gymnast did. Loriah copped best with the hardness of the floor but it aggravated Lucy Brett's already sore feet and Kate was very open with sharing her dislike of the Banfer floor area. Each girl also performed a dance through routine to check music was fine and positioning of dance etc. We went to vault as our last warm up piece and other than the landing being a little firm the girls all did the vaults required for the following day's competition. Once all pieces had been warmed up the girls did a very light core conditioning set and performed any necessary physio exercises followed by a good stretch. To my knowledge Kate was carrying a small back injury and Lucy had sore feet. Taking into consideration the length of time the gymnasts were up they managed very well with the evenings training.

Saturday 12th :

Saturday was competition day and provided a different set of challenges to manage as the girls had 2 training session prior to the actual competition. We had our 1st open session from 10:00-12:00pm and our 2nd was after our competition general warm in the form of an organised apparatus set warm up from 4:30—5:50pm.

First session —

We warmed up in our competition order Bars, Beam, Floor and Vault. All the girls were expected to go through one whole routine on each piece with their necessary warm up set from their personal coaches unless on the day Leigh and myself felt something extra was needed or equally not as much was needed. The girls went through all pieces with no real issues. Other than floor where Lucy explained to us that she knew her limitations and that she wouldn't be able to safely execute her double tuck on the Banfer floor. Kate also had a similar problem with her double pike which resulted in us deciding to pull the double pike out of the routine as Kate thought she would hurt herself if she did have to do it. Kate had a few ups and downs with her beam warm up in this session. In the time we had between the 1st session and the 2nd session we spoke to the team and explained the order they would all compete in so they could prepare themselves mentally and be ready when the comp started.

Second session —

This was our timed pre-comp warm where we had 10 min on each apparatus, we went round as in the comp with the Germany 1st team following us having the 10 min warm up slot directly after us. The girls came into the comp arena with a much more focused attitude and knew after the first Session of the day exactly what was needed from them. They all warmed up much better. We found as a team that we had to be quite tactical with our warm and made sure the entire 10min was used as we only used 7min on floor and noticed the German 1st team were sneaking on and getting extra

time, after floor we made sure the entire 10min was used even if it meant doing simple landing drills on vault or extra dance lines on beam.

Competition —

Bars - Loriah was first up, went clean and got us off to a great start and Lucy and Katy followed suit with another 2 clean routines. All 3 girls hit all elements and connections.

Beam — Kate went up first this time and pulled out a really good routine considering her warm-up was a bit challenging. She went through clean, with only the slightest of wobbles on her flick layout. In warm-up Kate struggled with her dismount but in competition she managed the double twist dismount with ease. Lucy was next and again went through clean and performed a very clean, well stuck routine with a R/O 1 V; dismount that was stuck dead. She scored 13.00 for her beam which is the highest she has ever got so that was a big confidence boost for her. Loriah was last up and fell twice unfortunately on her double side spin and flick layout. It was a shame because leading up to the competition she had been faultless on beam. After the 2 falls though she finished strong with all other elements being stuck.

Floor — As said before we decided to take out Lucy's double back and Kate's double pike. This was the right decision for us to make as our aim was to go clean as a team and to go home with no injuries. Lucy went up first and executed a very clean routine. All tumblers were stuck nicely and because she didn't have the double back it meant she was .5 down on her start value but Lucy made up for this with the artistry. Kate went up next and again was .5 down on her start value without the double pike but all her other tumblers were performed very well and again she made up for the loss with artistry and her leap series which was lovely. Loriah was last and performed a very respectable routine. All tumblers stuck without any wobbles or hesitations. '

Vault — Lucy went up first and executed a respectable straight Yurchenko. Kate went 2nd and again produced a decent straight Yurchenko. Loriah was 3rd and performed a very nice, high full twisting Yurchenko scoring 14.200. All 3 vaults had good, solid landings.

Overview

The competition was very nicely run, with lovely hosts who made us feel welcome and comfortable. We had a fantastic experience as a team.

Thursday 10th October

The team assembled by 9pm at the Premier Inn London Gatwick Airport (A23 Airport Way). The flight was smooth and on arrival we took one MPV taxi to the Lindner Bay Arena Hotel, where we arrived around 9.30am. We were all hungry by this time, as we had eaten our packed breakfast on rising, so we had a bite to eat in the hotel. We then went to the Smidt Arena, just across the road from the hotel. It was still set up for basketball but it gave the girls an idea of the size of the competition venue. We then went for a walk to pass the time, but as it had started to drizzle we weren't out for too long. Back at the hotel we rested/slept, followed by a late lunch, and another rest sleep (as everyone was so tired from such an early start). Training was from 6.00-8.30pm. The girls started with general warm up and lines, then moved around the apparatus in FIG order, starting on Bars.

From my perspective as HOD I was impressed with the girls' skill levels. I checked the playing of Land of Hope and Glory, just in case we won the Team event. From a judging perspective, Germany 1 (seniors) and Germany 2 (juniors) both looked strong and well prepared -. GTV de Hazenkamp (a club team) from The Netherlands also had some very nice work, one gymnast in particular had 5 different spins on beam (connection of 1/1 spin with leg above horizontal into single spin on the other leg, 2/1 spin, connection, although not always joined, of 1'2 spin with leg above horizontal into illusion 1/1). The other club team from The Netherlands were not arriving until tomorrow, the 2 gymnasts from South Africa and the team from Slovenia were of a reasonable standard but there were to be at least 4 good teams fighting to get on the rostrum. A good spread for dinner was provided at the competition venue then back at the hotel Ross, Leigh and I attended the Coaches and Judges meeting. England were to start on Bars - the team must have been telepathic as that was the order they had trained in! We were paired with Germany 1, going up first on each rotation.

The first gymnast on each piece in each rotation was to perform one at a time, on the announcer's cue, to orientate the audience - this was nice for the girls to be centre of attention. Judging positions were read out - I was D1/E1 on Beam. We submitted our working order that Ross & Leigh had already prepared and were given our accreditation, souvenir programmes and posters. At the close of the meeting we were all invited to join the organising committee for welcome drinks in the bar. It was a nice end to a very long day.

Saturday 12th October

Training was from 10am — 12pm. Loriah and Lucy did what they needed to do and had another good session. Katy was suffering with a sore back and again had problems with running out on Floor. Ross handled the situation very well. I just hoped that the adrenaline would kick in this evening and that she would get through her routine. After lunch we returned to the hotel to rest for a few hours before returning for the competition. The Judges meeting at 5pm was conducted in German, as there was nothing to be said that was any different from the meeting the night before. My D2 was Petra Schulz from Hamburg and she and I had to do both D and E scores as we only had 3 other E panel judges.

Katy was up first for England with an attacking and positive routine which she stuck, with just a couple of 0.3 errors on layout and split change 'A' (D 4.9, E 7.85). Loriah went up next, she fell on her tuck spin, which was unfortunate as it had gone so well in training (we credited 1%) but Petra had wanted to only give 1/1), and then uncharacteristically she fell on her flip layout, which was a shame

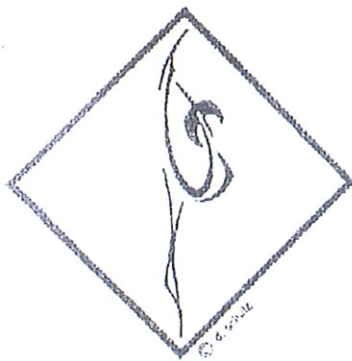
as the rest of the routine was clean (D 4.6, E 6.2). Lucy had a big wobble on her tour jete but confidently nailed the rest (D 4.6, E 8.4). Germany 1 had one fall and two high start scores of 5.3 and 5.8 which included a 0.1 bonus for split change into sheep jump. Germany 2 had only one fall but this gymnast received 0.3 in bonus for front salto into Jump, split change into tuck back and free walkover into split jump). Once gymnast from GTV de Hazenkamp received 0.1 bonus for split change into free cartwheel and 0.1 for her first spin combination, but the second combination that had been touch and go in training didn't count, and unfortunately she fell twice. A team mate also had two falls, so that was probably what ultimately cost them 3rd place. The other Dutch team had four falls and their extra gymnast, who also worked as there was no 8th team, also had two falls. The South Africans shared three falls, and Slovenia had four. So it was not a particularly stable day on Beam!

The girls knew at the end of the competition, from the results displayed on the big screen, that they had come 3rd, but not until the presentation did we realise that Katy had finished in 4th (her competitive nature clearly must have come into play) and Loriah and Lucy were =5th. We were all pleasantly surprised too when the apparatus medals were announced, Loriah 2nd on Vault, Lucy 3rd on Beam and Loriah =2nd on Floor. So a very successful outcome. The girls were inundated with fans requesting autographs and photos with them, such that we were the last team to leave the arena. , After a quick turn around for the banquet back at the hotel, it was a shame that with an already small field of teams, one German and one Dutch team had left straight after the competition. The gymnasts exchanged gifts informally and our girls spent the rest of the evening with the South Africans. At the end of an enjoyable evening in good company we said our thank yous and farewell to Gaby, Dieter and the organising team. They very much hoped that we'd personally return in 2 years' time, with the event possibly being staged in the November, when Dieter and Gaby respectively celebrate their 75th and 50th birthdays, and it would be the 40th Leverkusen Cup.

Sunday 13th October

After a late and leisurely breakfast, and having had the help of the Vice President of the Club, Reinhold (who is also the Commercial Director of the Bay Arena), who had negotiated a very late checkout of 6.30pm of the girls room, we took a taxi to Aqualand - unfortunately the pool that was in walking distance was closed for renovation, which hadn't been clear on their website when I had researched it before the trip! The South African gymnasts, and the mother one of them, came with us. The girls deserved this treat and we all had a fun afternoon. We returned to the hotel and after a very late lunch we met up with Reinhold for a guided tour of the Bayer Leverkusen football stadium. We were very privileged to be given access to the players' dressing room, the hydrotherapy room, the media and press conference areas, the various lounges, boxes and VIP seating areas, plus the team bench, the Pitch and the stands.





Lucy's Dad was there to meet her, but Katy's Mum was slightly delayed as it had taken 4 1/2 hours in the traffic to get down from Nottingham (and she had to turn around and go all the way back, I didn't envy her that). With everyone safely on their way, my duty as Head of Delegation was complete. It was a huge responsibility but one that I would like to thank English Gymnastics for giving me the opportunity to experience, as well as the selection to judge for England at this friendly well organised competition. Thanks also to Ross and Leigh for their good company and being the best dressed coaches at the banquet, and to the gymnasts enabling me to be part of a successful team.




