- Voluntary Levels 2018

Vault - Tsukahara & Yurchenko

Judging will be as per judging guidelines published on the BG website 11.9.13 (to be updated). Please see the additional guidance below:

Level 4

The landing position for the Tsukahara & Yurchenko to knees should finish with an open hip angle.

Landing with bent hips 0.10 / 0.30 / 0.50

If there is any fall there will be a deduction of 1.00 plus 0.30 if there is under rotation.

In addition, if the gymnast lands on feet and then drops to knees, or their feet touch landing mat before knees:

Weight on feet 1.00

Brush feet 0.10 / 0.30 / 0.50

Land on seat 0.50

Brush seat 0.10 / 0.30

Land on back 0.10 / 0.30

Level 3

Brush feet 0.10 / 0.30 / 0.50

Land on seat 0.50

Brush seat 0.10 / 0.30

Land on back 0.10 / 0.30

The body should stay straight / slight dish from the table until the gymnast lands on her shoulders on the landing mat

Women's Artistic Technical Committee

If only one vault is performed the second vault will score 0.00 and the scores will be averaged.

Level 3 Bars

After clarification of a question, the sole circle (5.108) can be used as a close bar element once only.

- British Citizenship

As per the WAG 2018 Handbook, in order for a gymnast to take a British Title, they must have British Citizenship.
