Position: Part-time, self-employed starting in September 2022 for the academic year

Requirements:

- Coaches must hold a Level 1 or higher Coaching Qualification in Women's Artistic, Men's Artistic, General Gymnastics, Acro or TeamGym
- Attend one coaches meeting per semester

Key Responsibilities:

- Working with other coaches to plan and deliver structured training sessions - Helping gymnasts set and work towards goals
- Helping prepare gymnasts for competitions
- Attend events, competitions and Gymfest as a coach (dependent on qualification and requirement)
