#### Staffing

### Reports from Technical Committees:

### M.T.C.

Last year financially was a good year, the MTC kept to the budget and made a profit, and this was done running three competitions and holding squad training at the New College Leicester.

This year competitions have already started and should once again be a success and see us making a profit.

The MTC continues to work well together and the competitions run well, although Karen has decided to step down as she no longer has any ties with a gym club and her health is still causing problems. I would like to take this opportunity to publicly thank her for all her hard work over the years for the East Midlands and to the MTC.

We have a new member on board as of this AGM and Josh Champion will become the judging convenor for the MTC. It is hoped that Miro will join the team as well as squad coordinator.

The performance clinics and camps have been successful and we have seen a good amount of coaches attending although it would be great to see even more new faces. This year we have managed to get Lee Woolls and Luke Folwell to run the clinics and their knowledge and experience have made the clinics and camps excellent. Our positions at Nationals improved slightly last year so something must be working.

We continue to have a good representation from the newer clubs in the region and I'm happy to announce that the Notts boys now have Josh and Matt at the helm and we hope this will strengthen our position as a region at Elite and club level.

Because of Rio and other circumstances we have had to re jig our calendar a little but we hope going forward into 2016 will bring the right kind of results that we want to see from the boys in the region.

# Overview of Regional activities

The region has 28 womens artistic clubs an increase of 3 on 2014. Seven competitions were held including grades, floor and vault, county & club teams and voluntaries at seven levels from level 5 for 8yr olds through to full FIG. Entries were down slightly on the previous year but this was mainly in the grades competitions where BG had insisted on all competitors had to have silver membership even the eight year olds competing in their first level grade. The wtc requested that the whole area of membership be placed on the agenda at the National wtc conference which was held in January 2016 but although it was discussed it was stated it was not their decision. Our Chairman also spoke to BG but the requirement for silver membership still stands.

In 2015 we had 35 gymnasts engage in the performance pathway programme spanning 6-8 clubs, we also had approximately 50 gymnasts who attended for the original testing. Of those engaged in the programme positive improvements have been seen in the gymnasts and coaching level, a variety of clubs have been selected for national teams. Unfortunately BG has now changed the format to a National squad being chosen from competition results thus regional training will cease in this format but the wtc will be discussing other options to start up squads once more.

Coaches have been very receptive to the clinics and taken on board preparations and

ideas which they have filtered through their clubs.

The East Midlands wtc will be moving to online competition entry in 2016 using the BG/East Midlands website...

# Courses coaching judging etc

5 Level 1 course total number of candidates 57 1 Level 2 course total number of candidates 9

2016 proposed courses: 4 level 1 & 3 level 2 and places are still available on these courses

No judging courses have been held in 2015 but 2016/17 will see the code of points being reviewed with revalidation courses at all levels being held spring/summer of 2017.

## Areas of Achievement

I must congratulate Becky & Ellie Downie on their amazing results in 2015 culminating at the World Championships in October and Ellie becoming the BBC young personality of the year and we wish them both sucess in their pathway to Rio 2016.

The region does have guite a few gymnasts in the England & GB squads but these come mainly from one Club but hopefully this might change to a few more Clubs in 2016.

# Areas of concern/issues

The region must endeavour to improve the level of gymnasts who are entering National competitions. The National Grades teams tend to end in the middle to bottom of the other regions but at Compulsory Grades & In age voluntaries we are bottom or last from bottom. 2015 was made even more difficult by Notts Academy Level 4 gymnasts moving to a new Club and not entering the Voluntary Level 4 competition which made the team weaker than in previous years. Hopefully some of these gymnasts will compete at Level 3 in 2016.

The region does need to encourage more individuals to come forward to help with the committee and competitions especially the younger generation so that they are ready to take over when the existing committee feel the time is right.

### RHYTHMIC,

The Regional rhythmic clubs have had another good year.

We have one new club now affiliated to the Northants County, however are still to affiliate to the region. All Northants clubs are operating at capacity with waiting lists mainly due to the availability of training facilities and the fact that all coaches are volunteers with commitments elsewhere, Erewash have a few spaces available for Rhythmic Gymnasts.

Number of active coaches: L1 - 3 L2-8 L3-2 L4-1 L5-2

Number of qualified judges: Club - 6, County - 5, Regional 5, National – 1, Brevet 1

## Squads:

Northants County squad suffered a set back last year when one club temporarily withdrew, however it is hoped that all clubs will be involved in County training again by the end of 2016. Erewash Valley were invited to attend some our County sessions as guest to build on our collaborative working.

All competitive clubs have gymnasts and coaches attending Zonal training on a regular basis. Erewash Valley had 1 gymnast – Antanaska Kirilova selected to be part of the GB Espoir Squad in 2015.

### Competitions & Events:

Gymnasts from the Region have competed at all levels over the last year including Novice, County, Regional, Zonal and National competitions in both individual and group format. Among the highlights were Northampton's Gym fest performance, Nene Valley's Rose Cup and Northampton's Dance and Duos competitions, Billings and Erewash first season in the National League and Nene Valleys appearance at the British Championships in Liverpool.

#### 2016 Plans:

Billings, Northampton and Erewash Valley, will be entering the National Group League this year and we wish them luck. Northamptonshire clubs are currently preparing for the County Championships and Novice Competition, which will be held on 13<sup>th</sup> March at Weavers, Wellingborough, and then will all meet at the Zonal, Grades and Regional Competing in April 2016, we are then organising a Novice Level 1 & 2 competition in the region in June.

Both Erewash (3 gymnasts) and Billings (2 gymnasts) entered this year's British Flexibility Testing.

Finally I would like to congratulate Vicki Pearson on being selected to judge at this summer's Rio Olympics.

#### ACRO,- No report received

<u>GFA</u> – Richard stated that the GFA programme had remained the same with same events and roughly same number of participants as previous years.,

#### TRAMPOLINING,

<u>DISABILITIES:</u> The East Mids have and will this year host the National NDP's. We have 1 British Champion and 2 downs syndrome girls that went to Milan to compete in the Downs syndrome world champs, we have 1 senior gymnast competing in WA British champs in Liverpool in April on all four pieces, a contigent went to LA for the special Olympics and in trampoline British champs we had gymnasts placed 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>. Support from WA judges is growing in the region.
