Role Detail

England Foundation Programme Coach

The role of the England Foundation Programme Coach for Double Mini Trampoline (DMT) is to deliver the technical and practical elements of the programme. The programme delivery is fully aligned to the England DMT Performance Pathway Programme (and thus the GBR DMT Performance Pathway Programme) and is focussed around the development of England 9-12 year old gymnasts and their personal coaches selected onto the programme, assisting with their progression up the Pathway.

Key Work Areas to include

- 1. <u>Training and Preparation Coach on the England Foundation Camp Programme</u>
- Delivery, review and coach/gymnast feedback after each camp
- Mentoring and guidance of the personal coaches
- Delivery and pastoral care duties during the two one day zonally based England
 Foundation Camps and one Central Camp (based at Lilleshall National Sports Centre)
 each year:
- Possibility of assisting with the following International Events:
 - Frivolten Cup May 25-29th 2022
 - Loule Cup Oct 26th 30th 2022
 - Home Nations Competition Nov 3rd 6th 2022

2. Programme Curriculum Development

- Coaches will be involved in the development of annual programme content under the guidance of the England Lead National Coach, Performance Pathway Manager and EGA Technical Chair
- Assist with the provision of operational programme information and feedback reports to review the England DMT programme activities to ensure the effective and efficient delivery of the programme
- 3. Continued Professional Development
- As part of ongoing CPD, this role will be expected to be available for any opportunities that may be offered to shadow ENG/GBR National Coaches

- Excellent 'people skills' and be able to encourage, motivate and help lead all involved in the development and support of gymnasts
