REGIONAL ACRO PROGRAMME REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS AND PRE-LIMS

Levels:

- An advanced level competition for pairs and groups
- NDP Grades 1-5 + IDP
- Disability NDP Grades 1&2
- FIG
- The prelims for NDP national finals

Competition Rules: (see also LG generic rules)

- Clubs must be Acro registered & affiliated to LG
- Gymnasts must be current minimum silver BG membership
- Gymnasts must be minimum age 9 years in the year of competition
- Gymnasts may only compete in one partnership (unless also in disability partnership)
- Routines last for a maximum of 2 minutes
- Tariff sheets emailed to designated judge prior to event
- Additional rules in the NDP section of BG Acro Handbook

Event entry:

- On-line entry on BG website
- Music up-loaded on BG music portal
- Judges ratio = 1judge 4 partnerships per club
- Each club must nominated at least 1 judge to be eligible to enter the event
- Selection of judges made from judges nominated on-line
- There will be a charge of £50 per judge, if the correct number of judges are not nominated or fail to attend the event
- No refunds after closing date of entry
- Work plan & parent' letter published 2 weeks prior to the event
- One tariff sheet per routine must be emailed to the judging coordinator by the prescribed date.

Injury:

- Should one member of a partnership sustain an injury after the closing entry date, a substitution may be made, up to one week before the event.
- The event organiser must agree to the change before it is confirmed.
- The substitute must be of the same grade as the injured gymnast. The new partnership will receive a score, but would not be eligible to progress to the finals.
- Should the new partner be out of age, the partnership may 'guest' at the competition, but they will not be formally placed in the results.
- Changes cannot be made during the week running up to the event

Coaches:

- Nominated, supervising coaches must be level 2 or above in Acro
- Current gold BG membership
- Assisting coaches may not coach the gymnasts unless they have the appropriate qualification to the level of the skills being performed
- Assisting coaches may sit with the gymnasts to supervise them.

Height deductions:

- NDP = 0.10 0.30
- DG = 00
- OoA = 0.10 0.30
- 11-16 = 0.10- 0.30
- 12-18 = 0.10- 0.30
- 13-19 = 0.30- 0.50
- Sen = 0.30- 0.50

Inquiries:

- Coaches must not approach the judges.
- Inquiries are only permitted in accordance with FIG regulations, with a payment of £15.00
- Only nominated supervising coaches may submit a written inquiry, for their own gymnast/s to the competition organiser /announcer
- The inquiry decision of the judges' superior panel is final.

Medals & Trophies

- Gymnasts must wear gymnastic attire for the awards ceremony
- Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd places in each category
- Trophies will be presented to the highest scoring partnership in each category.
- In the case of a tie break for first position: maximum tariff, then highest values, then greatest number of highest valued elements will be considered.

Progression:

- From the Regionals, the first placed NDP partnerships will progress to NDP National Finals.
- 5 partnerships will be selected as the London Team in the National Team Finals.
- The top two Disability Partnerships in each category will progress to National NDP Disability Finals
- The Silver and Bronze Partnerships will progress to the Southampton Regional Championships at selected grades
- [if any club is not willing for their gymnasts to take part in the Southampton Regional Championships they must indicate this to the competition organiser prior to the prelims]

Regional Tracksuits:

- Gymnasts and coaches representing London must wear the London Regional Tracksuit / Kit.
- Tracksuits may be ordered on-line through the LG website

Mobile Phones:

- Gymnasts, coaches, judges and officials must not use mobile phones or any other electronic communication devices, including tablets, in the main arena during the event.
- London Gymnastics and the Acro Technical Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry and disqualify a competitor, group, coach or judge at any time, if they do not comply with BG or LG published regulations.

NATIONAL PROGRAMME National development plan 9

NDP 9 emphasises technical excellence over difficulty and artistry, and provides for smaller step-changes in element difficulty.

Coaches should read the up-dated NDP 9 regulations and competition handbook before embarking upon NDP coaching and competitions

PARTNERSHIPS Progression through the NDP is at the discretion of the coach:

The gymnast's maturity
The gymnast's ability
