

PLATTEN SCHOLARSHIP – FAQ'S

Please note that questions regarding the Platten Scholarship must NOT be sent to British Gymnastics

Who is eligible to apply for a Platten Scholarship?

Coaches, judges and volunteers involved or working with a London Gymnastics affiliated club.

Which courses are eligible for grants?

L1, L2, L3 theory L4 & L5 coaching courses, disability modules, judging courses and WO courses

How do I apply for a Platten Scholarship?

Enrol on a chosen course & pay for it

What are the criteria for being successful in my application?

The applicant must have enrolled onto a British Gymnastics course and paid for it.

The applicant must be involved with, or working with a London Gymnastics affiliate club

The application must be received before the start date of the course

The application form must be completed in full

When will the application be processed?

The Platen Scholarship will be processed after the closing date of course enrolment, which is approximately 4 weeks prior to the start date of the course.

What is the application process?

The list of applicants is sent to British Gymnastics. British Gymnastics check that the applicant is enrolled on a course, that the course is paid for, and that the course will run. If all is in order an email will be sent to the applicant requesting bank details for payment. If the course is cancelled or the applicant has not enrolled or paid for the course the application will not be processed.

How much will my grant be?

The level of grants is approximately 25% of the full cost for coaching courses, with some variation for disability modules, welfare courses and judging courses. The level of grants to be awarded is set each year by the London Gymnastics Management Committee and may vary.

How will the grant be paid?

The grant will be paid directly by bank transfer.

Does the grant have to be paid into my bank account?

The grant will be paid into the bank that is nominated by the applicant on their Account Details. This could be their own account or that of the person/club who has paid for the course.

When will I hear if my application has been successful?

You will receive an email requesting bank details so that payment may be made. Other than that, the volunteers who run the scheme will not contact you or provide up-dates.
