### **GBR** Representation

Please find below results from the international competitions in Bulgaria this month.

On 23<sup>rd</sup>/24<sup>th</sup> May, we had a Junior team at the Sofia Cup. Gymnasts were supported by coaches Eva Balova and Ruth Wilson, and with the following results and a team placing of 14<sup>th</sup>.

Christina Vitanova – 43.900 (3 pieces) Hannah Martin – 41.955 (3 pieces) Alida Bogdanova – 29.050 (2 pieces)

On 26<sup>th</sup>/27<sup>th</sup> May, Laura Halford competed in the World Cup in Sofia, supported by Jo Coombs as coach and Nia Evans as Judge, with an overall score of 61.150 (29<sup>th</sup>)

## Judging courses / Revalidation of Judging Qualifications

As you may be aware, the Code of Points changes every 4 years. The current cycle (2013 to 2016) is shortly coming to an end, and the new Code comes into effect on 1 January 2017. Anyone who has attended a judging course during this cycle but not yet passed the exam or completed the relevant judging requirements to obtain their award, needs to complete these by 31 August 2016 in order to gain that judging qualification for this cycle (thereby entitling them to revalidate at that level for the next cycle). If you still need to complete your exam and/or judging requirements, and don't have any arrangements in place, please contact Karen Crutchley, Judging Coordinator.

<u>All</u> judges who wish to judge next year and onwards will need to attend a revalidation course on the changes relevant to their level of judging qualification, and pass a short theory exam on them. Revalidation courses will be held early in 2017, and dates and details will follow in due course.

For the above reasons, there is only one more judging course which will take place this year, which is a County judge course to be held in Scotland as follows:

Date: 23 July, 12.00 - 16.00

Venue: Scottish Gymnastics Office, South Gyle, Edinburgh.

Cost: £65.00, including exam fee.

**Exam**: to be held in Edinburgh, although arrangements may be made for candidates who are not local to sit the exam at an alternative location / time to suit the available invigilator. Note that the exam and any judging requirements must be completed before the end of August 2016 as per the above.
