FIG Code Clarification

We are aware that there has been some uncertainty as to the requirements for the CC Collaboration following the recent Code of Points changes. We have obtained clarification from the FIG on this, and can confirm as follows:

- there must be 2 different types of transmissions (i.e. cannot be 2 bounces only, but could be 1 bounce and 1 roll. There doesn't need to be two of each type of transmission - so you don't need 2 bounces and 2 rolls, for example)
- the 2 transmissions could be simultaneous or sequential
- the same apparatus could be used for the both transmissions, or different apparatus could be used
- the transmissions could be carried out by the same or different gymnasts (though all gymnasts must be involved in the Collaboration in some way)
- the same type of transmission (i.e. bounce, roll) could be used in more than one CC, as long as it is different (eg different body part, plane etc). However, the Artistic Faults judges will be looking for variety so coaches should be wary of all Collaborations within the exercise looking the same/similar)

Open Individual Apparatus & Group Seeding

Due to travel and weather condition, this competition will now take place on the 20-22 of April at Fenton Manor. All gymnast entries and entries fees will be transferred to this new event date. Should any of your gymnasts be unable to take part, then please email [Mindy Davies](#) and British Gymnastics will make arrangements to refund their entry fee to the club basket.

Similarly, all spectator tickets sold thus far will be valid for the new date.

Unless there are significant numbers of withdrawals, the event schedule and working orders will simply be transferred to this weekend. It is also assumed that your nominated judge will still be available for the new date. If they are not available, please can you contact [Karen Crutchley](#), as a matter of urgency so alternative arrangements can be considered.
