Reminder of change to Uneven Bars measurements

Both bar rails will be raised by 5cm for all gymnasts, effective 1st January 2022.

The new measurements are 175cm for the low bar and 255cm for the high bar.

The new inner diagonal distance between the bars will be a maximum of 182cm. Tall gymnasts may still request to raise both bar rails by an additional 5cm according to the Code of Points rule.

The WTC confirm that these bar heights will be used for all National competitions including NDP Finals.

Artistry on Beam and Floor for CoP Cycle 15 2022-2024

Compulsory 4 & 3 Pass Mark

Compulsory 4 Pass mark 51.00

Compulsory 3 Pass mark 51.00 (with a minimum score of 10.00 on Range & Conditioning)

The first four gymnasts who have achieved the minimum score of 51.00 (with a minimum score of 10.00 in Range & Conditioning) will represent their Region in National Finals.

The gymnast in fifth place will be the nominated reserve.

Gymnasts who score 56.50 or more in their Regional competition but do not finish in the first four can enter the National Finals as an individual.

Gymnasts who fail achieve a minimum score of 10.00 in Range & Conditioning can have one additional attempt at the end of the competition.

FIG Challenge

FIG Challenge Regions must nominate a minimum of one and maximum of two FIG level competitions to allow gymnasts the opportunity to qualify for FIG Challenge. These dates must be sent to the National Competition Organiser.

Gymnasts must achieve an All-Around score of 41.50 from one of these competitions to qualify for the FIG Challenge.

Reminder regarding Competition Attire

We would like to remind coaches that penalties will be taken at all National Competitions for incorrect attire. For clarity, this is valid for all competitions.

Reminder regarding elements not in the CoP Cycle 15 2022-2024

Please note that for National competitions, all new elements that are not in the CoP need to be submitted to WTC in writing with video evidence in advance of the competition in order that they can be given a value.

Club & Regional Grades

With the lifting of Covid restrictions, we would like to remind everyone that gymnasts can only pass Club & Regional Grades and receive certificates at a Regionally sanctioned event. Gymnasts are not able to take their grades out of Region without prior permission from WTC in conjunction with the Regions involved. Invitational events / pre-grades where certificates are not issued are welcomed and unaffected.
