



Spring Event Series 2020 – Trampoline FIG Approval Panel Process

The Approval Panel has been introduced to maintain the integrity of the performance standard at FIG Level and to ensure coaches are introducing the gymnast/s they coach at the correct level of competition.

Who will be required to attend the Approval Panel?

1. Any gymnasts who wish to enter the 2020 Spring Events Series, FIG Level:
 - a. who did not demonstrate (in 2019) the minimum difficulty performance standards as per 2020 requirements for FIG Performance Level or as per 2019 requirements for FIG Development Level
 - b. who have not competed at FIG Performance Level before

Scores, from any Domestic competitions may be submitted for consideration demonstrating the required DD for FIG level 2020

What will be required to be demonstrated for the Approval Panel?

- FIG Level Range & Conditioning with a passing mark
- 1st Routine requirement – 17-21yrs and seniors only
 - A complete routine that includes the stated technical requirements (plus minimum DD for first routine) and with a minimum execution score of 7.5
- 2nd Routine requirement – all age groups
 - Complete routine with the minimum difficulty performance standard and with a minimum execution score of 7.0

Clubs will be required to submit video evidence of each requirement and for each gymnast that they wish to be considered for entry into the 2020 Spring Events Series, FIG Level.

Approval Panel Process – Gymnasts that did not achieve the criteria referred to above (1.a):

1. Clubs who require gymnasts to be considered for entry into the 2020 Spring Events Series are asked to contact the Olympic Programme Officer (Trampoline) by Friday 13th December. Please confirm the club name, followed by the name and age group of each gymnast to be considered. Please also confirm the name and email address of the contact within the club who will be responsible for uploading gymnast videos.
2. Once the Olympic Programme Officer (Trampoline) has received all relevant information, a link and guide to uploading videos will then be sent to the club contact. Clubs are asked to submit all videos by Wednesday 18th December 2019.
3. The Approval Panel will review videos by Friday 17th January 2020.
4. The Olympic Programme Officer (Trampoline) will notify clubs of the outcome by Wednesday 22nd January 2020. Please note that decisions are not open to appeal.

Approval Panel Process – Gymnasts who have not competed at FIG Performance Level before referred to above (1.b)

1. Clubs who require gymnasts to be considered for entry into the 2020 Spring Events Series are asked to contact the Olympic Programme Officer (Trampoline) Monday 13th January 2020. Please confirm the club name, followed by the name and age group of each gymnast to be considered. Please also confirm the name and email address of the contact within the club who will be responsible for uploading gymnast videos.
2. Once the Olympic Programme Officer (Trampoline) has received all relevant information, a link and guide to uploading videos will then be sent to the club contact. Clubs are asked to submit all videos by Friday 24th January 2020.
3. The Approval Panel will review videos by Monday 3rd February 2020.
4. The Olympic Programme Officer (Trampoline) will notify clubs of the outcome by Wednesday 5th February 2020. Please note that decisions are not open to appeal.

For gymnasts who have not already submitted a video and did not compete in the Regional NDP qualifier in March, a further opportunity to submit a video to compete in Spring Event Series 2 will be available as follows:

- a. Contact Olympic Performance Officer (Trampoline) by Friday 6th March 2020
- b. Submit video by Friday 13th March 2020
- c. The approval panel will review by Wednesday 25th March 2020
- d. The Olympic Programme Officer (Trampoline) will notify clubs the outcome by Monday 30th March 2020 (closing date for SES 2 3rd April)

The NTTC would advise that as a back up, an entry into the March Regional qualifier may be an option.
