## NATIONAL TRAMPOLINE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

Following on from the 'pilot' competitions that were able to take place in 2020 and based on discussions with the DIS panel and Technical Committee, the following changes will be introduced for 2020/21 competition season:

### DIS DMT

- Club Level - which is for club and regional development and will not qualify to NDP Individual and Regional Team Finals
- NDP Regional Level - this level will qualify from the Regional NDP Compulsory Final in March through to the NDP Individual and Regional Finals
- FIG Development Level – this level will compete at the Spring Event series with qualification to the British Championships providing minimum standards are achieved

Where skills are indicated in red, gymnasts can choose to use a mount or a spotter skill but must still ensure that the same skill is not used in the same place in another pass, otherwise the DD for the repeated element will not be awarded. All 4 passes must remain different.

### **Qualification to NDP Individual & Regional Team Final**

Top ranked gymnast from each region, per category, per gender will qualify to the NDP Individual & Regional Team Final, providing all passes competed are as stated above and the minimum total score is achieved.

No more than **1** gymnast may progress to the NDP Individual & Regional Team Final. In the event of a tie for a qualification place, the following tie-break rules will be used:

- (1) The gymnast with the higher total E-score prevails
- (2) If there is still a tie, the gymnast with the higher E-score from the final two passes prevails

### **Spring Events**

- Cat 1 Men/Women
- Cat 2 Men/Women
- Cumulative score will determine the ranking
- Incomplete/incorrect routines will result in a zero 'DNF' score

### **Qualification to British Championships**

The top 10 ranked gymnasts, per category, per gender from the Spring Event Series Events will qualify for the British Championships. These qualifiers will be calculated from the best cumulative total score (2 round) providing all minimum standards have been achieved.

### **British Championships**

Compulsory Round 1

Optional Round 2 (Top 8 Zero Final)

- Pass one and pass two, in the compulsory round must be competed in the order stated above. Failure to do so will result in a penalty of 3.0 by DD judges
- Top 8 ranked gymnasts following Round 1 will progress to Round 2 (Final)
- The starting order for the Final will be in order of merit, the gymnast with the lowest total score in the Qualifying Round going first.
- Scores for Round 2 (Final) will begin from zero
- However, in groups of fewer than 8 gymnasts scores will not be reset to zero. Cumulative 2 round (4 pass) score will determine the ranking
- The DD of individual elements are capped according to the limits set out in the qualification scores table above
- A nominated panel (Member of NTTCC, Chair of Panel & 1 x appropriately qualified coach) reserves the right, but not the responsibility, to end a performance (during training, warm-up or competition) that is deemed to be unsafe at any time.
