Notice of main changes to the National Competition Structure 2017

All gymnasts entering the NDP or FIG Pathway should refer to the membership section on the BG website for level of membership required (gymnast/gymnast membership/ BG NDP structure)

FIG Double Mini-Trampoline (DMT)

Change to minimum standards for qualification – move to minimum total scores as means of qualification across all levels

Gymnasts will compete 2 passes in the qualification round at the British Championships and 2 different passes in the final.

FIG rules will be used at the British Championships with the exception of the 'zero' score. This will not apply at these Championships and there will be no zero final, all scores will be accumulative. (The 'zero' score will remain at the Spring Event Series).

Age Groups/Senior

Optional Round 1

Optional Round 2

There are no compulsory passes at this level. It is up to the Coach and Gymnast to create appropriate passes to meet the minimum expected total scores using the guide DD and knowledge of average landing deductions received for that gymnast historically.

All 4 optional passes must be different; any repeated element will result in a loss of DD for that element.

- Incomplete routines (passes that according to FIG ruling would score zero, or only be marked out of 1 skill) will result in a zero 'DNF' score
- Gymnasts receiving a zero 'DNF' score will not be awarded a medal
- A nominated panel, (Member of NTTCC, Chair of Panel & 1 x appropriately qualified coach) reserves the right, but not the responsibility, to end a performance (during training, warm-up or competition) that is deemed to be unsafe at any time

Qualification to the British Championships

Gymnasts must achieve the minimum expected total score (cumulative two-round score achieved at the same qualifying event) shown below to rank for their respective age groups.

The top 16 ranked gymnasts, per age group, per gender from the Spring Event Series Events will qualify for the British Championships. These qualifiers will be calculated from the best, cumulative two-round preliminary total score (achieved at the same qualifying event) providing all minimum standards have been achieved. Gymnasts only have to qualify with the minimum expected total score.

There is automatic entry to the British Championships for any gymnast who represented Great Britain in the European Championships (Senior & Junior) 2016 or World Games 2017, however unless agreed otherwise by the HNC, gymnasts should have competed in at least one of the Spring Event Series events. Any such automatic entry is in addition to the top 16 qualifiers.

British Championships

Round 1 – Optional passes 1 & 2

Round 2 – Optional passes 3 & 4 (Top 8 final)

- All 4 optional passes across rounds 1 and 2 must be different; any repeated element will result in a loss of DD for that element
- FIG rules will be applied (except scores will not be reset to zero for the top 8 final)
- Top 8 ranked gymnasts following Round 1 will progress to Round 2 (Final)
- 2 round accumulative score (4 passes) will determine the ranking
- A nominated panel, (Member of NTTC, Chair of Panel & 1 x appropriately qualified coach) reserves the right, but not the responsibility, to end a performance (during training, warm-up or competition) that is deemed to be unsafe at any time
