Notice of main changes to the National Competition Structure 2018

All gymnasts entering the NDP or FIG Pathway should refer to the membership section on the BG website for level of membership required (gymnast/gymnast membership/ BG NDP structure)

FIG Double Mini-Trampoline (DMT)

17-21yrs age group will be adopted in line with FIG

Warm up hall – all four passes should be warmed up in warm up hall. On Field of Play there will be a two touch warm up then compete passes 1 & 2, a further two touch warm up and compete passes 3 & 4

Qualification scores will be confirmed after the World Championships and World Age Group Competition

FIG rules will be used at the British Championships with the exception of a 'zero final'. The 'zero score' will not apply at these Championships and all scores will be accumulative. (The 'zero' score will remain at the Spring Event Series)

Age Groups/Senior

Optional Round 1 passes 1 & 2

Optional Round 2 passes 3 & 4

There are no compulsory passes at this level. It is up to the Coach and Gymnast to create appropriate passes to meet the minimum total scores.

All 4 optional passes must be different; any repeated element will result in a loss of DD for that element.

- Incomplete routines (passes that according to FIG ruling would score zero, or only be marked out of 1 skill) will result in a zero 'DNF' score
- Gymnasts receiving a zero 'DNF' score will not be awarded a medal
- A nominated panel, (Member of NTTC, Chair of Panel & 1 x appropriately qualified coach) reserves the right, but not the responsibility, to end a performance (during training, warm-up or competition) that is deemed to be unsafe at any time.

Qualification to the British Championships

Gymnasts must achieve the minimum score (two-round cumulative score achieved at the same qualifying event) shown below to rank for their respective age groups.

***Qualification scores will be confirmed after World Championships/World Age Group Competition 2017**

- For 9-10 & 11-12 age groups, the performing of triple somersaults is strictly prohibited and will result in disqualification.
- For all age groups (not Senior), the performing of quadruple somersaults is strictly prohibited will result in disqualification.

The top 16 ranked gymnasts, per age group, per gender from the Spring Event Series Events will qualify for the British Championships. These qualifiers will be calculated from the best, cumulative two-round preliminary total score (achieved at the same qualifying event) providing all minimum standards have been achieved.

There is automatic entry to the British Championships for any gymnast who represented Great Britain in the World Championships or World Age Group Games 2017 or the European Championships (Senior & Junior) 2018, however unless agreed otherwise by the Performance team, gymnasts should have competed in at least one of the Spring Event Series events. Any such automatic entry is in addition to the top 16 qualifiers.

British Championships

Round 1 – Optional passes 1 & 2

Round 2 – Optional passes 3 & 4 (Top 8 final)

- All 4 optional passes across rounds 1 and 2 must be different; any repeated element will result in a loss of DD for that element
- FIG rules will be applied (except scores will not be reset to zero for the top 8 final)
- Top 8 ranked gymnasts following Round 1 will progress to Round 2 (Final)
- 2 round cumulative score (4 passes) will determine the ranking
- A nominated panel, (Member of NTTC, Chair of Panel & 1 x appropriately qualified coach) reserves the right, but not the responsibility, to end a performance (during training, warm-up or competition) that is deemed to be unsafe at any time
