Working Groups

The Rhythmic Gymnastics Technical Committee (RGTC) is looking to appoint working groups to support and co-operate with the development and implementation of specific projects and events.

Each working group will be asked by the RGTC to work on one or more projects at a time, related to the 6 working group areas. The scope of each project will be defined by the RGTC, and the working group will be asked to report back to the RGTC with proposals for RGTC's consideration. Final decisions as to whether and how a project is to be implemented will be made by the RGTC, not the working group.

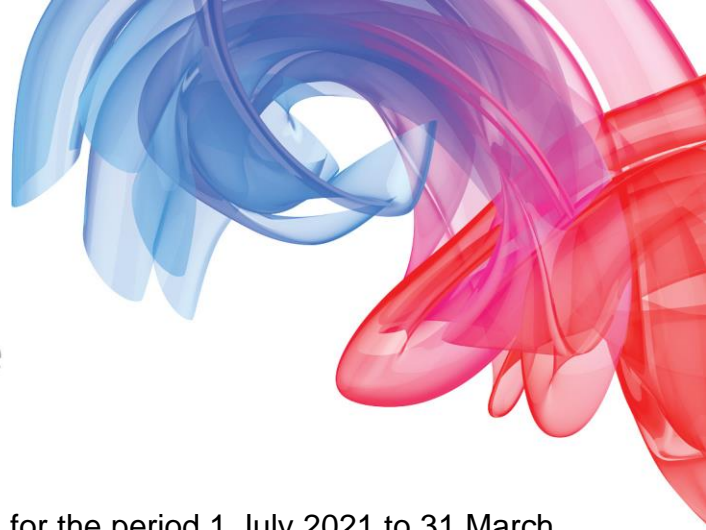
Each working group is expected to consist of 3 to 4 members, who will be appointed for a term of approx. 1 year. The re-appointment process will be held each year, and existing members will be able to apply for re-appointment. Individuals can only sit on one working group at a time (other than RGTC members). In the unlikely event that a member of the working group is not able to serve, the RGTC will be responsible to find a replacement.

The working group will initially meet approximately once a month. The working group Chair will be responsible to provide draft meeting agendas along with support materials to the working group and RGTC, at least 7 calendar days in advance of the meeting. Draft products, summaries and minutes following each meeting with identified actions and discussion, should be submitted to the RGTC. Zoom meeting facilities will be organised by the disciplines Sport Programme officer.

The working group might choose to invite Technical Advisors with special knowledge and expertise to provide information and/or advice. Advisors will be encouraged to participate in discussion but shall not participate in the decision-making of the working group.

Members of each working group will be selected based on the required pre-requisites/experience set out in the working group scopes. Members must have full BG membership, have completed the BG required GDPR e-learning modules, and hold any relevant qualifications for the working group's area. Being on a working group is an unpaid, voluntary role.

Each working group member will be expected to conform to the BG Standards of Conduct for Coaches, Instructors, Officials and Judges.
