

TeamGym Brevet Contract 2022-2024

To attain Brevet status is an achievement and an enormous honour. On behalf of the TeamGym Technical Committee (TGTC) we would like to take this opportunity to congratulate you on your nomination for the International Judging course for this cycle. When you represent Great Britain or act in the capacity as a Brevet judge, be it a domestic event or otherwise, we are obliged to remind you of the judge's oath and also to remind you of the continuous assessment conducted by European Gymnastics whereby Accuracy, Bias, Consistency, Discipline and Ethics are assessed by the Technical Committee (European Gymnastics) following every sanctioned event. When on duty Brevets are always expected to be professional and conduct themselves appropriately. Great Britain has a good record throughout of consistently providing senior judges at European events for a number of cycles. We are therefore keen to ensure that judges representing Great Britain are a credit to the country and our judge education programme.

EXPECTATIONS	How they can be achieved...
1.0 Good representative of British gymnastics / membership in good standing.	Adhering to codes of conduct / protocols. Refrain from actions or words that might bring the sport or British Gymnastics into disrepute.
2.0 Respected within the discipline.	Ensuring up to date knowledge is applied at national events; working positively with Superior Juries; Responding positively to club requests for assistance in preparation for events (not at events); maintaining high standards of objectivity.
3.0 Up to date knowledge.	Studying the EG Code of Points; FAQs; Clarifications; Equipment Directives; UK Mods; UK Competition Handbook; TGTC Updates (on the BG Website)
4.0 National Support* 4.1 Judging Internationally 4.2 Judging at Domestic Events 4.3 Supporting the Performance Programme 4.4 Supporting the Education Department	4.1 At ECH or other international events where the TGTC appoints judges. 4.2 British Championships, British Qualifiers & GB Selection Events. 4.3 Evaluating routines and reviewing tariffs as requested by the senior officials I.e. Performance Manager; TGTC; National Coach; Unit Leaders. 4.4 Contributing towards education material; Delivering Judge Education Courses if requested; Seminars/Webinars.

* TGTC respect that some brevets may serve other disciplines or also represent GBR as coaches or gymnasts. Therefore, the TGTC will take a flexible approach to help such individuals fulfil their service as TeamGym brevets.

JUDGING DECLARATION

- I confirm I will make every effort to fulfil the expectations of a brevet and understand that if I can not, that the Technical Committee will review their support for my Brevet attendance at the next International Judges Course.*
- If selected for international sanctioned events I will make all reasonable attempts to attend the event. Where you have restricted holiday opportunities please document this with your response below.
- Where there is a dual role as a coach and a Brevet judge; if selected as a coach for a major event I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that I have sufficient events to maintain my Brevet / progress my category.
- I understand that I am unable to be selected for any international events (including the brevet course) without returning this signed contract to British Gymnastics.

*If a brevet is concerned about fulfilling their brevet expectations the TGTC would welcome the opportunity to discuss and find solutions where possible. However, if the TGTC feel that they cannot in good conscience support a brevet application they will endeavor to notify the judge before they attend any selection exams.
