DMT Clarification

The new FIG code of points has caused some confusion around the repetition of elements in our DMT competition structure. To clarify any misunderstanding, the following will be the case:

The Regional Challenge Cup Series and Final levels will continue to apply the repetition rules from the previous code of points. Therefore, individual skills or elements **may** be repeated across the 4 competition passes (2 compulsory, 2 voluntary) as long as the individual element appears in a different phase of each pass - mount, spotter or dismount.

All FIG performance competitions (Spring Cups, NAGF and British Championships) will employ the new 2022 FIG code of points and the repetition rules within, as outlined below:

Q1 – no element may be repeated across the 2 passes of the Q1 round, regardless of where the element appears in the pass. The 2 passes of the Q1 round must contain 4 completely unique elements.

Q2 – elements may be repeated from the Q1 round. However, any repeated element must appear in a different phase of the pass, otherwise no DD will be awarded for the repeated element.

F1 and F2 – Elements may be repeated from any of the preliminary rounds. However, no element may be repeated across the 2 passes of these final rounds, regardless of where the element appears in the pass. The 2 passes of the F1 and F2 rounds must contain 4 completely unique elements.

- It is our intention to proceed with in-person assessment for our national judges this year. A programme will be communicated once the FIG brevet revalidation process is concluded for our international judges.
