

Judge's Code of Conduct

Women's Artistic Gymnastics

Standards of Conduct

- 1. Judges must hold a current cycle judging award.
- 2. Judges' membership level must be Bronze or Life Members of BG for Club or Regional, and Gold, Joint Gold or Life Members of BG for National and Brevet Judges, before being allowed to officiate at a BG event.
- 3. Judges must wear the correct uniform, this includes a dark blue suit and white shirt/blouse (men should wear a tie).
- 4. Judges should check the competition details before the event.
- 5. Judges must contact the judging organiser as soon as possible if unable to attend an event so a replacement can be found.
- 6. If appointed as a reserve judge they should keep the date free until the day before the competition. Judges must inform the judging organiser immediately if they become unavailable.
- 7. Judges are expected to arrive on time for the judges' meeting prior to the competition.
- 8. Judges must be in place for the start of the competition.
- 9. Judges must be prepared thoroughly on all apparatus.
- 10. Judges should keep up to date with all the official information from the FIG and BG WTC.
- 11. Judges should practice their judging whenever possible to ensure accuracy and familiarity with current trends in the sport.

During the competition judges must:

- 1. Behave at all times in a professional manner and exemplify non-partisan ethical behaviour.
- 2. Adhere to the judges regulations in the current Code of Points.
- 3. At all times treat fellow judges, coaches, gymnasts, officials and volunteers with respect and courtesy.
