

Announcement Regarding the 2019 RHG Senior World Championship Selection process.

After reviewing the Domestic and International scores achieved so far in 2019 against the published requirements in the Selection Policy, the RHG Nomination and Approval Panels have reached the decision that there is not sufficient supporting evidence to make any GBR entries for the World Championships definitive entry deadline on the 19th June.

The stated performance targets in the policy ‘that each gymnast must be able to score an average of 15.00 on each routine competed’ is clearly a long way from being achieved and even the Qualification Target Score of 14.00 average across 3 pieces is challenging at this point in time.

Also as the Team entered needs to be at least 3 gymnasts to meet the format requirement, the Panel feels that both the quality and depth available sadly does not justify making a definitive commitment by the 19th June deadline.

This is therefore formal notification that the GBR Selection Trial process planned to be held alongside the British Championships 25-28 July, will now not take place.
