



## BRITISH GYMNASTICS' SELECTION POLICY

### Tumbling Gymnastics

#### Senior World Championships, Tokyo, JPN

**28<sup>th</sup> November – 1<sup>st</sup> December 2019**

<p>1. Introduction</p>	<p>The Senior World Championships is a PERFORMANCE competition. A Performance event means that selections will be made on the basis of the athletes most capable of performing and challenging to win medals.</p> <p>The selection of athletes to represent Great Britain at the 2019 Senior World Championships will be made according to this selection policy.</p> <p>Athletes should note that for all major championships, each delegation may enter a maximum of 4 entries in total for men and 4 entries for women.</p>
<p>2. Performance Targets</p>	<p><i>These Performance Targets and the selection principles applied in this policy reflect the long-term direction and aims of the Tumbling Performance Programme to consistently challenge for medals at World Games, World Championships &amp; European Championships during the 2017- 2021 cycle and beyond.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individual Men – Qualify 1-2 Athletes to the Final</li> <li>• Individual Women – Qualify 1-2 Athletes to the Final</li> <li>• Medal Target – 1 to 2 individual Medals and 1 to 2 Team medals</li> </ul>

Selection Process / Timelines</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Designated Selection Events – April to September 2019</li> <li>• Nomination Selection Meeting – Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2019</li> <li>• Nomination to Approval Panel – Tuesday 1st Oct 2019</li> <li>• Approval of selection – 10.00am Wed 2nd October</li> <li>• Communication of selections to gymnasts/coaches – midday Wed 2<sup>nd</sup> Oct</li> <li>• Appeals Deadline – midday Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October</li> <li>• Team Announcement – Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October (Time to be confirmed)</li> <li>• Nominative Entry – TBC</li> </ul>
<p>4. FIG Entry deadlines</p>	<p>British Gymnastics is the selecting body that enters the GBR team to the FIG/Organiser. The timelines for entry to the World Championships 2019 are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provisional Entry – TBC</li> <li>• Definitive Entry – TBC</li> <li>• Nominative Entry – TBC</li> </ul>

5. Competition Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• FIG Competition, FIG Code of Points</li> <li>• Senior Men’s Individual &amp; Team</li> <li>• Senior Women’s Individual &amp; Team</li> </ul>
6. Eligibility Criteria	<p>Athletes are eligible for consideration provided they are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a British Citizen, holding a British passport</li> <li>• a minimum of 17 years old in the year of competition (born 2002 or older)</li> <li>• a current British Gymnastics member</li> <li>• eligible to compete for Great Britain by possession of a current Gymnast Licence held with FIG</li> </ul>
7. The ‘Team’	<p>1. The ‘Team’ means the team which is selected by British Gymnastics and includes Athletes, coaches, nominated reserves, medical support personnel, judges, Team Leaders, Heads of Delegation and any associated members of the Performance Sport staff.</p>
8. Nomination Panel	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Following the completion of the Designated Selection Events listed in this Policy, the TUM National Coach will consult with the Assistant National Coache(s) &amp; the Non-Olympic Performance Manager and take into account any relevant input deemed necessary from the Performance Sport Science &amp; Medical staff to discuss the nomination of the Athletes and coaches.</li> <li>2. The nomination panel will take place on Sunday 29 September 2019. This will be chaired by the Non-Olympic Performance Manager. In attendance will be the appointed National Coaches, Trampoline Technical Committee Chair and Judging Coordinator.</li> <li>3. The nominated Athletes and coaches will be those, in the expert opinion of the Nomination Panel, most able to achieve the targets listed in the section ‘Performance Targets’.</li> <li>4. Following this consultation, the Non-Olympic Performance Manager will forward a list of nominated Athletes and Coaches to the Approvals Panel on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2019</li> </ol>
9. Approval Panel	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A British Gymnastics Approval Panel, comprising the Performance Director and Head of Performance Programmes will consider the nominations for Athletes and coaches received from the Nomination Panel and ratify if appropriate.</li> <li>2. In the event that the Nomination Panel provides insufficient Athletes to fill the available Team places, the Approval Panel will make referral back to the Nomination Panel for their reasoning at which point their list of nominations may be amended.</li> <li>3. The Approval Panel will confirm the selection of the Team by 10.00 hrs 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2019.</li> </ol>
10. Communication of selections	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Once the Approval panel confirm the selection of the team, the Non-Olympic Performance Manager will notify all age eligible British Squad Athletes and their personal coaches by midday 2 October 2019</li> <li>2. Once selections have been communicated, the 48-hour appeals window comes into effect.</li> </ol>

	<p>3. Athletes and Coaches shall refrain from making any public statements with regard to team selection until the appeals window has closed.</p>						
<p>11. Athlete /Appeals</p>	<p>4. Appeals can only be submitted from midday 2<sup>nd</sup> October up to/until midday on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2019, for a non-selected gymnast on the grounds that the process outlined within this Selection Policy has not been adhered to.</p> <p>5. The selection of coaches and judges is not open to appeal under any circumstance.</p> <p>6. Appeals should be made following British Gymnastics' Appeals Process. <p>12. Designated Selection Events</p>	<p>The Nomination Panel will take into consideration performances at the following events:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. British Championships, 28 – 29 September 2019</li> <li>2. GBR Domestic competitions and International Competitions taking place between (March 2019 – September 2019)</li> <li>3. Control competitions at GB National Squads (March-September 2019) may also be considered provided Brevet level judging is used.</li> </ol> <p>Priority consideration (subject to appropriate fitness and form being demonstrated at the above events) will be given to an Athlete that won a medal at the World Championships 2018.</p> <p>In order to be considered for selection, a gymnast who is ill or injured prior to or during one of the Designated Selection Events must provide written authentication of the injury or illness by one of the medical personnel approved by British Gymnastics (listed at the end of this Policy). This documentation must be submitted to the Non-Olympic Performance Manager.</p>						
<p>13. Nomination Process</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Athletes will be selected on the basis of achieving the best result for Great Britain.</b></li> <li>2. By entering the selection process, Athletes and personal coaches agree to be bound by the provisions of this policy.</li> <li>3. Athletes meeting the eligibility criteria and who are members of the British Gymnastics Tumbling Senior National Squad will automatically be considered for nomination.</li> <li>4. <b>Athletes meeting the eligibility criteria who are not members of the British Gymnastics TUM Senior or 17-21 National Squads may petition the Nomination Panel for inclusion, presenting evidence against the standards outlined in this section. The petition should use the form at the end of this policy and should be sent to the Non-Olympic Programme Officer (TUM) <a href="mailto:Nadine.barnard@british-gymnastics.org">Nadine.barnard@british-gymnastics.org</a> by the deadline of noon Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2019.</b></li> <li>5. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6. <b>Team Size</b> - <i>Please note that the numbers of available selected places for the GBR Senior &amp; 17-21 Teams at the World Championships 2019 will be confirmed on the BG Website within 1 week of the finish of the Spring Series 2 event. This is to allow the TUM Technical Panel to assess the strength of each class relative to the required selection criteria published in the policy. This will allow more accurate entries to be made for the World Championships 2019 ahead of the selection process in September.</i></li> <li>7. Following the final selection event, (British Championships 28/29 September 2019), the World Championship Team will be nominated for selection based on athletes who are deemed the most capable of achieving the best results for Great Britain at the World Championships 2019.</li> <li>8. Should athletes not reach the required standards of performance, the nomination panel may nominate athletes who are deemed capable of achieving the best result for Great Britain or whose inclusion reflects the long-term direction and aims of the TUM Performance Programme (see section 2).</li> <li>9. Nominated Athletes and coaches will be expected to undertake all programme activities (Camps and Competitions) laid out by the Tumbling National Coach as part of the preparations for the Championships to prove their readiness to compete. All routines must be agreed in consultation with the GBR Senior Tumbling National Coaches.</li> <li>10. Nominated Athletes and coaches must also agree to observe all obligations outlined within the British Gymnastics' Performance Athlete Agreement 2017 – 21 and any subsequent Codes of Behaviour adopted by British Gymnastics.</li> <li>11. Team Coaches will be nominated based upon consideration of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The team's best needs</li> <li>• Their ability to lead, organise and control in situations of responsibility and stress</li> <li>• Their international experience and performance</li> <li>• Their attendance at all required meetings, squad training and events.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
Injury & Replacement	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In the event of injury and/or the need for replacement, any gymnast may be called upon to join the Team at any time.</li> <li>2. Once Team selections have been confirmed by the Approval Panel, all selected Athletes must agree not to withhold any information on training fitness, injury status or illness that could affect training or competition at any time until the point of the Championships.</li> <li>3. All selected Athletes must declare any medications they are taking, the use of any restricted medications, and submit these to the Head of Science &amp; Medicine at British Gymnastics for medical approval.</li> <li>4. A gymnast or coach may be removed from the Team in the event of a non-compliance in training, a breach of responsibility to the Team or a violation of the Codes of Behaviour adopted by the Team. Prior to removal the gymnast or coach will be presented with the opportunity to attend a removal interview with the Head of Delegation (or their appointed representative) and where possible one other independent person. Written justification must be</li> </ol>

	<p>provided for all removals by the Head of Delegation. Decisions on these matters are not open to appeal.</p> <p>5. At any stage following the selection announcement and prior to departure to the competition, should any gymnast fail to reach <u>performance</u> expectations in training or competition, the TUM National Coach may recommend de-selection to the Approval Panel. The Approval Panel will consider this recommendation, provide an opportunity for the gymnast to make a counter-argument, and then pass judgement. Written justification must be provided for all removals. Decisions on these matters are not open to appeal.</p> <p>6. At any stage following the arrival of the Team at the competition and during the event, should any gymnast fail to reach <u>performance</u> expectations in training or competition, the TUM National Coach may recommend de-selection to Head of Delegation. The Head of Delegation will consider this recommendation, provide an opportunity for the gymnast to attend an interview to make a counter-argument, and then pass judgement. Written justification must be provided for all removals. Decisions on these matters are not open to appeal.</p> <p>7. At any stage following the selection announcement, should there be a doubt over the ability of a gymnast to compete to the best of his ability <u>due to an injury or illness</u>, the following procedure will be adhered to:</p> <p>a) The gymnast will be referred to British Gymnastics' designated Medical Officer to undergo a medical examination to determine their fitness to participate. Initially this will be based on an assessment of whether or not the injury and/or illness is such that the gymnast is physically unable to compete or is at risk of causing medical harm to themselves, or endangering other competitors, officials or spectators.</p> <p>b) If the gymnast passes the initial medical examination carried out by the Medical Officer but British Gymnastics still has concerns over whether or not the gymnast is able to compete to the best of his ability due to the underlying injury or illness, the gymnast will be required to undertake British Gymnastics' designated "Fitness Test".</p> <p>c) The Fitness Test is an objective assessment that will require the gymnast to perform routine(s) to 0.3 of their expected start value or final score.</p> <p>d) In the event that a gymnast fails to complete the Fitness Test to the required standard, they will be removed from the Team, a decision that is not open to appeal.</p> <p>8. Any replacement(s) required will be made by the TUM National Coach on the basis of the needs of the Team and will normally come out of the pool of nominated non-travelling reserves. Decisions on these matters are not open to appeal.</p>
Team Organisation	<p>1. The Team will attend pre-Championship Preparation Camps and competitions during Oct/Nov in accordance with the 2019 Activity Planner (dates subject to change &amp; TBC).</p> <p>2. The Team will transfer to Japan on/around Friday 22 November 2019 and depart the Championships on Monday 2 December 2019. (all dates to be confirmed)</p> <p>3. In the event that they have not already done so, all Athletes within the Team will be required to sign and comply with British Gymnastics' Performance Athlete Agreement 2017 - 21.</p>


	4. In the event that they have not already done so, all coaches within the Team will be required to sign and comply with British Gymnastics' 'International and National Representative Coaches Code of Conduct'.
Announcement	1. Selected Team Members agree not to make any announcement to the media or public in any form (including on any personal websites) regarding their selection until after British Gymnastics have announced the Team selection on the British Gymnastics website (www.british-gymnastics.org)
Any additional matters not covered by this Policy	1. Any matters arising from the selection process that are not covered within this policy shall be determined by the Approval Panel acting at their sole discretion.
